

General Body meeting of TNOA
held on Saturday, 05.08.2017 – 9.00am
at Texvalley, Erode

1. Meeting called to order by president

The GB Meeting was called to order by President Dr.V.PanneerSelvam.

2. Welcome

President welcomed all members to this important meeting and hoped for a structured and purposeful deliberations

3. Homage

4. Oration

The Prestigious Dr.Joseph Gnanadickam Oration was delivered by Dr.NirmalFredrick and the Dr GV Community Ophthalmology oration was delivered by Dr.AsimSil

5. Confirmation of the minutes of the last meeting

The Minutes of the previous GB meeting held on 05.08.2016 at VELEYE conference venue, Vellore was read by Hony Secretary Dr K Rajasekar.

The minutes passed and adopted proposed by Dr Mohan Rajan and seconded by Dr Ashok Kumar

6. Matters arising there from not covered elsewhere

7. Adopting the annual Report of Secretary

Hony Secretary Dr.K.Rajasekar presented the TNOA ANNUAL REPORT to the GB , compiling a comprehensive brief of the various activities of TNOA over the year, which will also be read at the inaugural ceremony. The secretary report also had activities and achievements of affiliate associations and member institutions and was widely appreciated and adopted proposed by Dr.BalajiRamanathan Seconded by Dr.ManojVasudevan.

8. Adopting the annual report of Treasurer

Dr N Rajeswari Hony Treasurer of TNOA submitted the audited accounts and report had wide discussion by the MC.

- a. Treasurer felt that we must open an additional bank account with internet banking in a different bank to keep check on deposits and payments frequently. Or else when TNOA conference A/C is handed over to Erode then reconciliation of the account becomes a difficult task.
- b. TNOA conference A/C service tax 7.85 lakhs paid and also the 30 lakhs given to AIOS Coimbatore conf had been returned.
- c. The final summary is a surplus of 2.96 lakhs income over expenditure and moreover a sum of 6.88 lakhs GST also paid

Dr.T.NirmalFredrick felt that internet or online banking was previously feared on privacy and safety but nowadays even Govt is stressing on only online transactions. We should open another bank account in a different bank and use it for online Reconciliation purposes only.

President Dr.V.Panneerselvam consented that we can start another bank account with internet banking

Dr.V.Siddharthan said that for the midyear conference during his team and also for the proposed Sale m conference the TNOA treasurer will be the LOC treasurer and will operate all accounts.

Treasurer report was passed proposed by Dr.M.Loganathan and seconded by Dr.M.Nivean

9. Adopting the audited accounts of last conference

Dr.T.S.MohamedSayee, Org secretary VELEYE 2016 presented the audited report of the conference accounts. President on behalf of GB thanked the Vellore team for the nice conference. There was detailed discussion on the conference having huge tax Burden especially the 18% GST which will be a really tough task. The Vellore conf account had been audited and taxes paid. Conference summary was budget 1.8 cores with income over expenditure of INR 6,88,655/ inclusive of a TDS credit of 4.36 lakhs. Drayed explained about the major expenditures and thanked TNOA for providing Vellore its first chance to conduct a major TNOA conference and it had been a cherished experience for members of that region.

10. Adopting the Report of Editor

Dr.T.Nirmal Fredrick presented the editor's report and thanked the Editorial team for cooperation in all spheres of journal work.

- a. In another 3 months time both ISSN and RNI will be completed. As we have engaged the services of Wolter and Kluwers the RNI regn from Kanchipuram has to be transferred to Mumbai
- b. He also released the new Website and said that it will help in all the Journal activities
- c. But the old archived journals will have name conflict and need to be in the Main website and can be viewed by our members
- d. Few small Indexing companies have indexed our journal and we will continue to apply for main Major indexing agencies
- e. The Tariff for advt is revised. And we shall give awards from sponsors for original contributions
- f. TNOA JOSR awards 2017-18 will be given for best presentations.

Dr.N.Rajeswari suggested for a big drive for increasing journal advertising amount collected and asked ways and means of meeting the expenses of the proposed Editor budget. Dr.T.Nirmal Fredrick felt principally the journal Editor cannot be expected to collect the advertises and this is not part of editors job.

President Dr.V.Panneerselvam told Dr.T.Nirmal that it is not correct to consider the income expenditure as a burden and if the proposals on the journal have to go ahead we have to in a more committed fashion think of more income.

DrV.Siddharthan said the Journal budget was 25 lakhs last year and is only 21 lakh this year and should be accepted. Secretary said that the conference budget of still earlier years have to be also compared to realize that the budget projections cannot be matched by conference surplus that too in the present Tax outflow scenario.

Dr.Madhivanan raised the point that there is confusion in the id used for the journal as the journal has different JOSR wording in email id and acronym is referred as TJOSR and email id is registered as TNOA JOSR. He requested all these to be made uniform.

Dr.Nirmal Fredrick accepted the suggestion and submitted that TJOSR will be the acronym, email id and registered name for the journal.

Editors report adopted and passed proposed by DrV.Siddharthan and seconded by DrV.Sharmila Devi

11. Adopting the Report of Chairman ARC

Dr.MohanRajan submitted the ARC report, also circulated in the printed annual report booklet circulated to all members, and presented the activities of the Academic and Research Committee

- a. ARC Chairman thanked his vibrant team ARC consisting of Dr.Ravishankar, Dr.Manoj kathri,Dr.MdSayee,Dr.Jayanthan,Dr.Chandrasekar, Dr.Saravana bava Dr.Devaki Senthilkumar, Dr.Ramesh and Dr.Suresh Paul
- * Preceptor ship of 6 – 7 young Ophthalmic doctors Dr.Shwetha, Dr.Sujay, Dr.Radha, Dr.Ravikumar and Dr.Kavitha have come to Chennai and learnt new technique at Rajan Eye Care and SankaraNethralaya.
- b. ARC revived the KK District Ophthalmic association by the well attended , (more than 100 members attending) CME meeting in nagercoil in coordination with IMA.
- c. On 27th Jan TNOA ARC had a ARC AIOS combined meet at BHU Varanasi and also have yet another same kind of session in this conference also
- d. TNOA ARC Neuroophthalmology meeting was conducted successfully by Dr.Namithaand Dr.Ambika of SN at Chennai
- e. Dr VR Vijayaraghavan had 2 days session PG classes in the TNOA ARC PG Update program which was well attended even by students from neighbouring states. DrK Rajasekar also conducted a class as part of PG update program
- f. TNOA ARC aims for a Golden triangle with Trade and industry to facilitate more proactive work in practice development of our members.
- * Future ARC programs are aimed at September (Vellore) December (Salem) November (Ramnad) and December (Trichy) also in Jan 2018(Nagarcoil)and sought cooperation from all
- * Joint program proposed with Aditya Jyot and MCOA at Saveetha university and thanked Immediate Past President Dr K Vasantha and the whole MC for their support in all the activities of ARC

ARC report adopted and passed proposed by Dr SS Sukumar and seconded by DrArumugaNainar

12. Ratification of New members

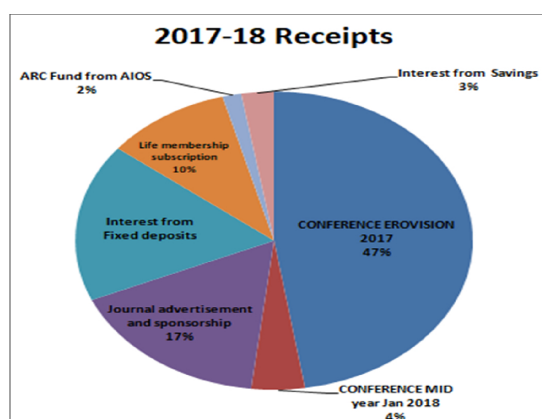

Financial Performance Highlights

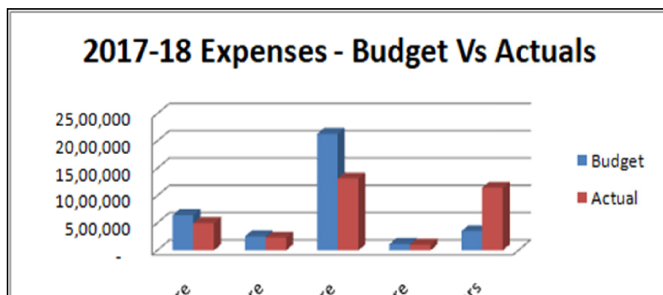

At the outset, I wish to express my gratitude to all the members of TNOA for entrusting the job of Editor of this esteemed Association and its journal.

“Every successful organization has to make the transition from a world defined primarily by repetition to one primarily defined by change.”

This is so true about the Journal of TNOA, now known as Journal of Ophthalmic Science and Research. Having taken over after a long wait in April 2016, it was very crucial to plan a strategy, timeline for the next 2 years. There were no articles to start with and not much time either.

We also had a dream of

- The long-awaited transition to an indexed,
- Online-ahead of print,
- Open-access
- Peer-reviewed
- Futuristic scientific journal.

How to accomplish this?

2 YEAR PLAN – CHALLENGES, ACHEIVEMENTS AND PRESENT STATUS

“All you need is the plan, the road map, and the courage to press on to your destination.

Sometimes it's the journey that teaches you a lot about your destination.”

- I. **STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS:** The statutory work - RNI Registration & ISSN was a big challenge. Approval from GB TNOA for our proposal to go ahead with RNI registration, name change, Indexing and the budget requirement – Aug. 2016. Starting with the statutory requirement of registration of the journal, the RNI registration process, **Title Verification has been done and approved by the Registrar, RNI Govt. of India, vide RNI reference No 1303157 and title Code: TNENG06019 dated 23.02.2017.**

As per the requirement of the Registrar of newspaper, the RNI Regn has been transferred from Chennai to Mumbai. Registration formalities at Mumbai office is being pursued. The formalities have been completed at Kancheepuram office. Wolters Kluwer pursuing the transfer of RNI registration to Mumbai.

ISSN for both online and print edition has been obtained, incorporated the online and print issues. ISSN for online – 2589-4536 and Print ISSN is 2589-4528. Journal also registered with the Netherlands database.

MOU signed with WolterKluwers for the Journal website management and publishing system in 2017 is valid till 2020.

II. AUTHORS, REVIEWERS – PRESENT STATUS AS ON 31ST JULY 18

We now have 101 authors, 28 reviewers in our TJOSR MMS Portal.

III. JOURNAL PUBLISHING AND THE TIMELINE of TJOSR: Due to RNI migration, new ISSN registration, and the advanced MMS system, our authors and core team, found it difficult to learn, adapt and adjust to the online system.

- We have made 4 videos to teach the authors, reviewers and editorial board members on uploading the new articles, handling the Website and Content management system.
- We also created and updated the power point tutorial for TJOSR, so that it will be useful for future editorial team and new members.
- In spite of all these changes and a difficult transition phase, we managed to release three issues in the last 6 months and kept the timeline in July 2018.
 - ☐ July – Sep 2017 issue in Feb 2018
 - ☐ Oct- Dec 2017 issue published online in March and print in April 2018
 - ☐ The Jan – March 2018 online released in May 2018 and print in June 2018
 - ☐ April – June by July 2018 and print last week of July / First week of August 2018.
- July – September 2018 issue :The full Table of contents is ready and after the new editor takes over, the draft journal, articles in the bank for the Oct to Dec issue along with the key to the MMS website and email will be handed over. The timeline will not be affected by the changeover.

The print issues are eagerly awaited and read by all our members. We are also sending the journals that are not delivered to members, to the libraries of medical colleges, so that the postgraduates and residents have easy access to our journals. Because of this initiative, we have got 6 institutional paid subscriptions so far. In view of the statutory requirement to have an Editorial policy to be adhered by the EB, we have formulated and adopted the following policy framework.

- V. **EDITORIAL POLICY:** standardized format of a cover page with picture from the relevant articles, format and printing style followed by all indexed peer reviewed scientific journal and a QR code for easy links.
 - a. **PEER REVIEW:** Apart from a Double review by editorial board and section editors, there is a peer review system in place. Original articles and Review articles are sent to two peers in the same super or sub specialty and review obtained. We now employ a double-blind review process, in which the author identities are concealed from the reviewers, and vice versa, throughout the review process.
 - b. **Plagiarism check:** all articles are checked for plagiarism by the plagiarism software and authors are advised to correct their article to reduce the plagiarism index. We return the articles if the plagiarism index is more than 50%.
 - c. **Preamble in international databases:** TNOA Journal of Ophthalmic Science and Research, a publication of Tamilnadu Ophthalmic Association, is now a peer-reviewed print + online Quarterly journal. The journal's full text is available online at <http://www.tnoajosr.com>. The journal allows free access (Open Access) to its contents and permits authors to self-archive final accepted version of the articles on any OAI-compliant institutional / subject-based repository.

VI. ABSTRACTING AND INDEXING INFORMATION:

The journal is registered with 12 abstracting partners: Baidu Scholar, CNKI (China National Knowledge Infrastructure), EBSCO Publishing's Electronic Databases, Ex Libris – Primo Central, Google Scholar, Hinari, Infotrieve, Netherlands ISSN center, ProQuest, TdNet, Wanfang Data.

We have now applied to index Copernicus, international journal list etc. for listing and indexing. If it gets approved, we will be in the list of indexed journals approved by the UGC and MCI. Since we are publishing the journal consistently in the standardized format, in xml database, we will be in a position to send application to other indexing bodies like DOAJ, Scopus, pubmed etc, soon.

- VII. **ARCHIVING THE JOURNAL of TNOA:** All the issues published by the Editorial board 2017 -18 are archived in pdf format for full journals and individual articles.

We have also Enhanced features on Journal on Web (JoW) to make it mobile friendly (to benefit the youngsters, who access the journal with their smartphones) and alert authors by email or sms alerts.

VIII. TJOSR Awards – 2017-18

- IX. **ISSUE OF NON RECEIPT OF JOURNALS:** There have been few complaints from our members regarding non receipt of journal. We are streamlining the system and auditing the delivery by the outsourced vendors. The complaints have reduced in the last two issues. The database has been updated recently by the TNOA secretary and hope the issue will be sorted out to our members satisfaction.

BUDGET and RESOURCES: The Budgetary allocation, revenue generation and the utilization report have been submitted to the treasurer's office for discussion and approval. The revenue generation through advertisers has been a challenge, due to Demonetization, GST and pharma regulations. I hope with the strong foundation laid in the last two year, the next team would be able to tap the full potential in terms of revenue generation to the TNOA. The draft budget requirement for the year 2018 -19 has been submitted to the treasurer office for in-principal approval

Way Ahead: New team, New Hopes: Since the statutory compliances are satisfied and well in place, with a robust technologically advanced manuscript management system (MMS), and an enthusiastic balanced editorial board / team, our journal is well poised to compete with national and international journals. By best wishes to the next Editor and the new team.

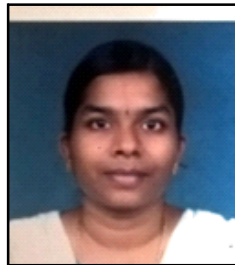

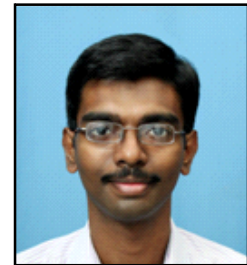

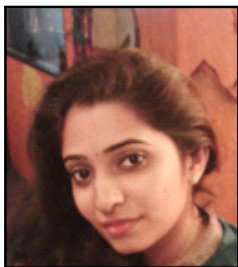
